



2020 Cleaning and Sanitizing Procedures

Updated 6/1/20

- Pool:
 - CDC guidelines indicate that standard chlorine disinfection kills the COVID-19 virus in pool water
- Bathrooms:
 - Boys/Girls:
 - Parents are required to accompany young children in the restrooms
 - Large groups of children in the restrooms is prohibited
 - Sinks equipped with touchless faucets, soap/towel dispensers
 - Shoes must be worn at all times when in the locker rooms
 - Bathrooms will be sanitized every 15 mins
 - Mens/Ladies:
 - Sinks equipped with touchless faucets (new)
 - Shoes must be worn at all times when in the locker rooms
 - Bathrooms sanitized every 15 mins
 - 16-and-over rule strictly enforced in the adult restrooms
- Lounge Chairs:
 - Lounge chair signs read: “This Chair is Sanitized”
 - When a member uses the chair, they should take the sign off and place it under the lounge chair
 - When the member leaves the facility, the lifeguard on cleaning duty will re-sanitize the lounge chair
 - The sign will then be placed back on the chair so members can differentiate clean/not clean chairs
- Tables:
 - Tables signs read: “This Table is Sanitized”
 - When a member uses the table, they should take the sign off and place it under the table
 - When the member leaves the table, the lifeguard on cleaning duty will re-sanitize the table
 - The sign will then be placed back on the table so members can differentiate sanitized/not sanitized tables

**If you would like your chair or table sanitized again, you should approach the lifeguard wearing a mask and gloves*

- Clubhouse:
 - *When the clubhouse is opened for member use, it will be sanitized every morning and after member use*
- Grills:
 - *When grills are opened for member use, there will be a check-in/check-out process:*
 - Grills labeled 1-4
 - To check-out a grill, member goes to the office and asks for the grill supplies (supplies in boxes that are sanitized upon return)
 - A lifeguard sanitizes the grill prior to member usage
 - Once the member returns the supplies to the office, a lifeguard sanitizes the grill/ supplies.
 - Example of the grill check in/check out:

| Date | Member # | Lifeguard | Grill # | Pre-Sanitation | Post-Sanitation | Supplies Sanitation |
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- Lost and Found - CANCELLED in 2020:
 - Traditional Lost and Found cabinet has been removed
 - All lost and found will be disposed of at the end of the day
- Tennis Towel Service - CANCELLED in 2020
- Lifeguard Cleaning Duty:
 - In addition to daily cleaning procedures, lifeguards/staff will complete the following:
 - Regularly disinfecting chairs, tables, countertops, all hard surfaces with bleach mix
 - Re/placing sanitation signs on tables/lounge chairs
 - Sanitizing bathrooms/the clubhouse
 - There will always be one lifeguard on “cleaning duty” (wearing mask and gloves)
